



THEME : UNDERSTANDING THE LAW OF HONOUR (Series 1)

Title : Honour The Lord Your God

Bible Reading: Proverbs 3:9 Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the first fruits of all thine increase: 3:10 So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

We will be having a series of teaching about honouring God, the king of Kings and the Lord of lords. The scripture above is teaching us to honour God not only with our mouth but with our substance.

Honouring God with your mouth is not enough, you need to teach your wealth to worship the Lord.

Many people know God, yet their money and substance is not susceptible, some people are born again yet their wealth does not in any way serve God. If you find it difficult for your personal car, house, and any other substance to do the

work of God, for example if no prayer meeting of some sort is held at your house, then you need the evangelism to your house. You must teach your money or wealth to honour God, you must teach your car to honour God, you must teach your house to honour God. CG what are trying to teach here? Remember what Moses told Pharaoh when instructed to leave cattles as they go to worship their God. Moses said:

Exodus 10:26 Our cattle also shall go with us; there shall not an hoof be left behind; for thereof must we take to serve the LORD our God; and we know not with what we must serve the LORD, until we come thither.

Moses understood that worshipping God without any substance is weightless. We need to honour God with our substance. The book of Acts leaves us challenged. Cornelius understood the idea of worshipping God with his substance. One day, he received good news.



Acts 10:3 He saw in a vision evidently about the ninth hour of the day an angel of God coming in to him, and saying unto him, Cornelius. **10:4** And when he looked on him, he was afraid, and said, What is it, Lord? And he said unto him, Thy prayers and thine alms are come up for a memorial before God. **Teach your money or wealth to worship God, money must not teach you how and when you should worship your God.**

Proverbs 3:10 So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

Empty barns are a clear testimony that you are not honouring God with your substance. There is what is called sacrificial giving, Abraham once did Sacrificial giving on the Mount of Moriah. He was honouring God with his substance; Solomon once did Sacrificial giving by offering 1000 cattles.

Now if you want to check the impact of this honour, study their end, Abraham became a great man and so is Solomon.

Teach your money or wealth to honour God, teach your car to worship God, teach your house to worship God every substance in your house must worship the Lord. May the Lord release the spirit of giving in our midst. As you go to your own congregation go and honour God with your substance God will open doors for your own prosperity.
