**2 Chronicles 32:27 And Hezekiah had exceeding much riches and honour: and he made himself treasuries for silver, and for gold, and for precious stones, and for spices, and for shields, and for all manner of pleasant jewels;**



*Reading through this same chapter indicates that the end story was not that good. This is what happens when you fail to manage the honor you are receiving from people. Failing to manage honor results in you being proud and the end is destruction.*
